

General Information

- Students are expected to attend all sessions of a class they are registered for. Absence of more than 2 days may result in withdrawal from courses. Students should not register if extended absence for any reason is anticipated (e.g. work, vacations, sporting events, family commitments).
- All Summer Session classes are based on sufficient enrolment and are subject to cancellation.



Elementary Registration

April 5 to July 7 (classes at most Elementary sites) and to July 14 (classes at Blacklock)

Online Registration - Current Langley School District Students Only Online registration is available only for current Langley School District students and is the quickest way to register.

- Steps to register online at <u>sd35.coresolutions.ca</u> 1) Choose "Create a new account" for new student accounts or choose "Use an existing account" for students who have registered
 - before. If a student has taken a Summer program before, please do not create another new account.2) Once the account is created or you are logged in, choose "Browse class offerings" to see the available classes and register for the class you are interested in.
 - 3) Once you register, an e-mail will be sent to you confirming the registration is "Pending".
 - 4) You will receive a second confirmation e-mail or be contacted by the Summer Session staff, usually within seven days, once they review your registration and it is "Approved".

In-person Registration - Current Langley School District Students and Out of District Students

In-person registration is available starting on April 5, 2016. For out of district students who were not part of the Langley School District for the 2015/16 school year in-person registration is the only option.

Please note that registration cannot be done over the phone - it must be done online or in person.

Information required when registering

- All students must have their PEN (Personal Education Number) to create a student account, a nine digit number located on report cards, permanent records or transcripts. Students should check with their current school ahead of time if they need assistance locating their PFN
- Student's legal and English name if different, phone number(s), address, and parent guardian(s) name(s) and e-mail address.
- If student was not registered in the Langley School District for the 2015/16 school year, proof of parent / guardian(s) Citizenship and BC residency plus the student's birth certificate must be provided.

International Students

- PLEASE NOTE: If you are an International student with the Langley School District you must contact the Langley International Student Homestay Department prior to registering for Summer Session 2016.
- After arrangements have been completed with the Homestay Department, students can then register in person at the School Board Office.
- Parents / guardians can pay the international students' course fee in person at the School District Board office by debit, credit card, cash or cheque. International Students withdrawing from courses are subject to a 10% processing fee. Refunds will not be given after July 5, 2016



• International students must bring a letter of permission signed by their Secondary School ISP Coordinator (ISP Coordinators have copies of the necessary form).
