### What do I need to know this week?

1. **Schoolcashonline:** This is the payment system we use at West Langley Elementary. It allows you to pay either with credit card or e-cheque. If you have never used School Cash Online we encourage you to sign up using the attached instruction sheet.

#### 2. Agendas/Supplies & Terry Fox Donations:

- 3. Meet the Teacher Night: As we are unable to gather in large groups at this time, we will not be hosting Meet the Teacher this year. Teachers will be connecting with individual families over the next two weeks to ensure you know who they are, the best ways to communicate and provide more information about your child's class. If you have any questions, please be sure to contact your child's classroom teacher.
- 4. Toonies for Terry We will be holding our annual Terry Fox Run on Thursday, September 24. We will begin our day with a remote assembly in our classrooms followed by each cohort running for approximately 20 minutes on our gravel field. Students are asked to wear clothes they can run in and be prepared for the weather. We will not be running as a school together this year in line with our PHO and district guidelines. Donations can be made using cashonline this year.

5. When do we arrive for school? Like last year, there is a 5-minute warning well at 8:31am. We have a staggered start this year so approximately half of the school begins at 8:36am and the other half will begin at 8:46am. Students should be arriving just before their start time.

8:36am: A-L students (students with the last names starting with the letters A-L) should be lined up at their classroom doors ready to start the day. Please do not arrive prior to 8:31am.

8:46am: M-L students (students with the last names starting with the letters M-Z) should be lined up at their classroom doors waiting for their teachers to open the doors and welcome them in. Please do not arrive prior to 8:41am.

We understand this is a shift in how we have welcomed students into the building in the past and thank you for your cooperation.

- 6. Can I bring birthday treats or goodies to share with my child's classmates? At this time, students are unable to bring food to share with others. If you have questions, please contact Ms. Lambie at clambiepottersmith@sd35.bc.ca.
- 7. Be prepared to go outside in any weather. Students should have coats, boots and umbrellas if raining as we will be spending more time outside this year.



8. **Students needing to leave the school**: If your child needs to leave part way through the day, please note that we are asking parents or designate to physically sign their child out with the office. Our Admin Assistant will meet parents/designate at the front door. Thank you for help.
