WHAT IS THE PAC?

The PAC, or Parent Advisory Council, is the officially recognized collective voice of parents of their school. All parents and guardians are included; there is no need to "join".

A PAC, through its elected officers, may advise the school board, the principal and staff of the school respecting any matter relating to the education of the students and the school (www.bccpac.ca).

The PAC is run by an executive, which is elected each year. Elections this year will take place at the Annual General Meeting, on Tuesday, May 18th at 6:30 p.m. on Zoom.

The executive positions are: president, vice-president, treasurer, secretary, DPAC representative, and members-at-large (3).

We are now seeking nominations for all executive positions for the 2021-2022 school year!



Vice President – Learns duties and responsibilities of the president in order to lead meetings in his or her absence.

Secretary – Records minutes of regular and executive meetings (i.e. takes notes about what is discussed/decided). Maintains a Minutes Book.

Treasurer – Custodian of funds. Disburses money according to the budget and notes transactions in the treasurer's records

D.P.A.C. Rep – Attends monthly District Parent Advisory Council meetings as a representative of our school and reports back to our PAC.

Member-at-Large (up to 3) – Attends all PAC and Executive meetings. Supports other Executive and can fill in if needed.
