With less than two weeks left in the school year, our District is looking forward to ending on a positive note. In the month of June so far, our District has not had a COVID-19 school exposure. This week the province announced details related to the recovery plan for K-12 education. The Minister of Education together with the Provincial Health Officer outlined a return to "near-normal" in September. This is welcome news and a huge relief for our system which has faced so many challenges in the last 15 months. All our students, staff, and families have worked hard to follow the guidelines to help keep everyone healthy and safe. Our District appreciates students, staff, and families for working together and supporting each other. Thank you!

The District will be spending time reviewing the K-12 Education Recovery Plan and working over the Summer to implement it in our schools. As announced by the province, we can expect the following to remain in place in September:

- Daily Health Checks
- Staying Home When Sick
- Diligent Hand Washing

As announced by the province, the following is expected in September:

- No Cohorts and Learning Groups
- The return of Sports and Extra-Curricular Activities

Our schools will continue to take direction from public health officials regarding mask wearing, which is expected to follow policy in the community, and will be updated in August. To help students and staff, transition out of the recovery phase of the pandemic, additional support will be provided for students with a focus on mental health and learning support. We are waiting for further details with respect to Ministry funding for the Langley School District. As was the case from the start of the pandemic, our District prioritized connection and creating a culture of care for all students. It is important for the community to understand, the province's announcement does not impact these last days of school. We want to emphasize that current health and safety guidelines in place will remain until the end of the school year and through Summer Session. We will be sharing more information as it becomes available and before the end of the school year.

The District and our community partners will be celebrating Langley Grad Week from June 21-25. We encourage everyone to do what you can to support and honour our grads.
